

## Prerequisite Policy

The department of Political Science enforces all course prerequisites as spelled out in the catalogue. Waivers are granted only in very rare circumstances with the consent of the instructor and the department chair, if there is sufficient evidence that the student has met the prerequisite(s) in some form. For the courses that have PSC 101 prerequisite, only PSC 101 or equivalent, as determined by the department, will meet the necessary requirement. Students are advised that meeting the university constitution requirement is not necessarily the same as PSC 101 for meeting a prerequisite, since the constitution requirement may be met by taking history, public administration or PSC courses. For those who transfer their US government courses from another institution, they still must take PSC 100 (Nevada government and constitution) to meet the prerequisite, since PSC 101 covers both the US and Nevada constitutions and governments.
